

RICHMOND AND LONDON STEAM YACHTS.

These elegant and rapid vessels will start, one of them from Twickenham every morning (except Sunday) at eight o'clock *precisely*, arrive below Blackfriars Bridge between ten and eleven o'clock, and return from thence in the afternoon, at three o'clock *precisely*, to Twickenham.

The other, from Queenhithe, London, every morning, (except Sunday,) at ten o'clock *precisely*, arrive at Richmond about noon, and return from thence at six o'clock in the evening.

ON SUNDAYS,

These vessels will start from Blackfriars Bridge, one at ten, and the other at eleven o'clock in the morning, *precisely*, to Richmond, and from thence to London punctually at six o'clock in the afternoon.

Fare on Sundays, three shillings for each passenger from London to Twickenham, or any shorter distance; and the same fare on the return to, or towards London, on Sunday evenings.

A commodious cabin is appropriated to the exclusive use of the Ladies, attended by a female servant.
