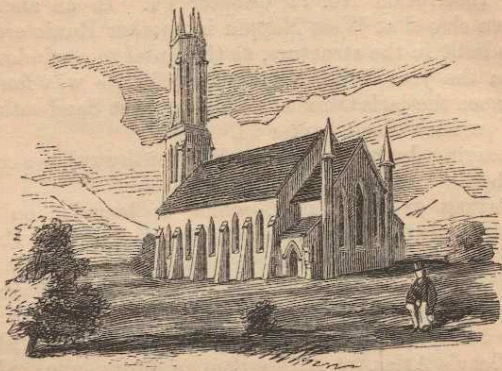


English style of architecture, contains seven hundred sittings. It was erected in the year 1832, chiefly by



money collected in England. The living is a rectory in the gift of the Crown.

The church register, the oldest in the island, commences in the year 1598. The Rev. Hugh Stowell, father of the celebrated Canon Stowell, of Manchester, was for many years rector of Ballaugh.

Whilst in this quarter, the tourist ought to visit the lovely vales called Ravensdale and Druidale.

Leaving Ballaugh, and taking a north-easterly direction, we return to Sulby Bridge; whence, pursuing an eastward course, we soon reach our original starting place, Ramsey.
