The Cathedrall Church of S<sup>t</sup>. Stephen in Vienna

At one of the doors of the Church there is a stone placed in the wall, which is generally conceived to be one of the stones wherewith St. Stephen was stoned. It seemed to me some kind of pebble, and is worn and polished by the hands of the people, who when they enter at that door, do touch it with their fingers. I was also shewed one of the stones which killed St. Stephen at St. Sernine, or St. Saturnine's Church in Tholouse in France, which is a Church abounding with Relique-Rareties, and where they also think they have the Bodies of se-
